c) Parish Plans

The Neighbourhood Plan Committee met prior to the Council meeting on the 11 February 2019. The re-application to Awards for All has not been successful, and they are now not willing to fund any further Neighbourhood Plans. Some work is still to go ahead but will need to be scaled back and the publication and printing of the completed plan will be affected.

The survey was distributed throughout the Parish and 131 surveys completed by the deadline of 31st January 2019, which is a good response rate of 20% of households. Out of the respondents 90% wished to be kept informed and 41 were interested in joining a steering group.

The overriding view was that the Parish is a nice place to live, no dramatic changes are needed, views, buildings and wildlife should be preserved. Concerns primarily connected with transport, highways and parking.

Andrew Towlerton is now to produce draft chapters on the findings, and steering groups can then help to complete with their local knowledge. The first themes are to be the Natural Environment and the Built Heritage.

19/00057/AMEND - Betron, Main Road, Cutthorpe - Non-material amendment pursuant of 18/00009/FL for dormer cil height raised and screen wall to jacuzzi area in lieu of obscured glazing.

A number of residents have raised concerns on this development and a petition is currently circulating in Cutthorpe.

Resolved: To object to the granting of the amendment. The Parish Council objected to the application back in early 2018 as it was considered over development of the site, would alter the street scene in a rural village, and be out of keeping with the surrounding properties.

This amendment has already been implemented, despite it being far removed from the conditional approval and is causing distress for the neighbouring properties.

It is requested that prior to determination that a site visit be carried out on this application. Also as the approved plans have not been adhered to it is asked that Building Control inspect the works undertaken to ensure that they meet with both the other conditions of the approval and are in accordance with the appropriate standards of building regulation.
