5. Preliminary report of Survey Results

The meeting received the preliminary report relating to the survey results, there are two further responses to be added. The main issues that have been highlighted are Transport and Traffic, Noisy Sports, School Parking, Planning Permission for Developments and Local Pubs.

6. To consider the initial introduction and natural environment sections

The Index at "4.5 Communities, Well Being and Getting Around" should be split to form "4.5 Communities and Well Being" "4.6 Getting Around" thus making "Monitoring and Review" number 4.7.

Section 2 – About Brampton – mini sections are required on each community, there is a website about Old Brampton, three books on Cutthorpe, more data is required on Wadshelf and Wigley. The Side by Side Website also to be utilised to show growth in the communities over time periods.

Section 4.2 – Natural Environment - Landscape

Point 31 Encroachment from development associated with nearby towns and developments were discussed, including the need to look at the Local Plan for Chesterfield

Borough Council. This is to ensure that historic settlements retain their own character and identity.

Section 4.2 Natural Environment – Distinctive View

A list of the best views is to be obtained, perhaps by contacting respondents and getting their thoughts on specific views.

Section 4.2 Natural Environment – Dry Stone Walls

To encourage retention wherever possible and to add hedges to the section.

Section 4.2 Natural Environment – Dark Skies

To balance retention of dark skies, with the requirement of sensitive street lighting for safety and security.
