#### 99/15-16 Public Speaking

##### a) Members of the public

Alison Davies addressed the meeting. She thanked the Council for authorising the use of inward facing vinyl banners around the Recreation Ground. Currently they have three potential sponsors – Copelands Estate Agents, Love Brewing and Advanced Plumbing and Heating and would like to offer a banner for the Cutthorpe Carnival. It was asked if these could remain in situ from Easter to September in line with the Cricket season.

Councillor Peter Margereson joined the meeting at this point.

The Cricket Club were asked to ensure that the litter is picked up after matches, though it is acknowledged that not all litter on the Recreation Ground is attributable to the Club.

The Cricket Club highlighted that when the play equipment was installed the contractor had damaged the pavilion, a provisional repair was undertaken, but this has not proved to be weather proof.
